News from the Volunteer Coordinator

The pandemic has been incredibly challenging for all of us. At Agape Table, we have been taking every precaution to minimize the possibility of transmission. Our staff and volunteers must always wear masks and face shields. To make sure that we don’t have anyone working with a fever, we check the temperature of our team with our fancy laser gun. We regularly ask our team to wash & sanitize their hands and change their gloves while volunteering. Our workstations are two meters apart and we limit how many volunteers we have in the building to around fifteen to ensure that we reduce our exposure to one another.

We would not have been able to continue handing out five hundred bagged meals daily without the help of our volunteers. They are our friends, our family, our heroes, and the best of our community. We are forever grateful for their support during this difficult time.

As inspiring as some of our experiences have been with the dedication and empathy we've seen in Winnipeg, we've also learned that COVID-19 does not discriminate. In the span of only 6 months, our daily numbers of meals served has more than doubled, and they continue to rise.

Message from the General Manager



2020 has been a very tough year, many of our staff, volunteers, donors, board members and guests have had to adapt to what is becoming the “new “normal.

Along the way many of us have had to deal with work closures, a loss of a loved one, learning the new math so you could teach your kids at home, and looking after your own mental health. With that in mind it is sometimes difficult to think of other people who may be struggling with poverty, physical health issues, mental health issues and/or emotional health issues.

We have projected serving approximately 110,000 meals and giving out almost 2.3 million pounds of food to the men, women and children of our community who need our

services this year. At Agape Table, we strive to bring awareness for our community that can't always speak for themselves, or are seldom heard.

Because of donors like YOU, this is all made possible! Agape Table is 100% donor funded and does not receive any funds from any layer of government. A simple token or gesture, given in the spirit of Agape (unconditional love) is the greatest gift of all. For every dollar donated, we can turn it into \$15 dollars of food for our guests.
