Message from the General Manager



Hi my name is Taome and I'm here to tell you about Agape Table.

Since my brother Atley was in grade 4, Mr. Young's class at Linwood School started a club called Linwood Leaders. That was 4 years ago, now I am in the Linwood Leaders program. We challenge the

school to collect hygiene items for Agape Table and their guests during the Christmas season.

Agape Table is one of 14 food centers in Winnipeg, and it has been around for 42 years.

They help feed the people in need every weekday from 7am till 11am Monday to Friday and hand out bagged lunches which have a sandwich, cup of soup, pastry, piece of fruit, some vegetables and a drink.

I know all this because my dad works there. In the last 7 years Agape Table has seen an increase of guests going from 66,000 in 2015 to over 125,000 in 2021. This year Agape Table will serve well over 130,000 guests.

On average Agape Table hands out over 500 bagged lunches a day with the record being 768 bags in 1 day.

Agape Table is 100% donor funded. That means they get all their money and supplies from the generous people and companies that live in and around Winnipeg. Agape Table can do a lot for their guests because of groups like ours that help them out. How can you or your company help Agape Table this holiday season?

Thank you for supporting the guests that my dad helps, by giving food, time, or a monetary donation. All of us can make a difference in someone else's life.
