What is a Third-Party Fundraiser?

A third-party fundraiser is an event or initiative organized by an individual, group, school or company in support of Agape Table. While the proceeds benefit our organization, the fundraiser is planned and managed by the independent organizer.

Getting Started:

- Once approved, we'll ensure you have what you need to make your fundraiser a success. Support from Agape may include promotional materials, logo files, social media recognition, and donation collection forms.

Tax Receipts:

Agape Table requires organizers contact us before your fundraiser to ensure proper guidelines and processes are in place if tax receipting is applicable.

Tax receipts are subject to Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) regulations.

Donations of \$20 or more paid directly to or processed by Agape Table are eligible for a tax receipt. We require all donors full name, phone number, and mailing or email address.

Note that, per CRA, tax receipts will not be issued...

- If the donor receives a product, service, or benefit in return for their contribution.
- To an individual or company for funds that they have collected from others.
- For event expenses or administrative costs.
- For in-kind donations of goods or food donated to a third-party fundraiser.
